OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Cancer treatment of CGHS/ CS (MA) Rules beneficiaries at Delhi

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Ministry's Office Memoranda, of even number dated the 6.11.06, 5.1.07, 2.4.07 and 1.10.07 on the above subject, in view of the hardships faced by CGHS/CS(MA) Rules beneficiaries undergoing treatment for cancer (both fresh and old cases) and pending a final decision on the application for empanelment in respect of the following hospitals, permission may be given upto 31.12.08, or till the empanelment procedure for hospitals providing treatment for cancer is completed, whichever is earlier, for the facilities / procedures for which they were empanelled under the CGHS during 2001:

1. Indraprastha Apollo Hospital, Sarita Vihar, Mathura Road, New Delhi
2. Batra Hospital & Medical Research Centre, 1, Tughlakabad Institutional Area, New Delhi
3. Dharmshila Cancer Hospital & Research Centre, Dharmshila Marg, Vasundhara Enclave, Delhi
4. Rajiv Gandhi Cancer & Research Institute, Sector-5, Rohini, Delhi.

2. As the above mentioned hospitals are presently not on the list of CGHS empanelled hospitals, the hospitals may not extend credit facilities to pensioners and hence the beneficiaries may have to claim reimbursement, at the rates notified in 2001 or actual whichever is lower, after getting themselves treated at the hospital. ✓
