CIRCULAR

Sub: Proposed Recruitment Rules for the post of Forest Rangers in the Department of Forests and Wildlife, GNCT of Delhi

The Department of Forests and Wildlife, GNCTD is proposing amendments in the Recruitment Rules for the post of Forest Ranger in the department. The proposed Recruitment Rules are put here below for eliciting comments /views of the stakeholders within a period of 30 days from today.

3	Classification	Central Civil Services Group 'B', Non-Gazetted, Non- Ministerial
4	Pay Band & Grade Pay/ Pay Scale	PB-2 i.e.Rs. 9300-34800 + Grade Pay Rs. 4200/- substituted by Level 6 of Pay Matrix in Cell-1
5	Whether selection post or non-selection post	Selection
6	Age limit for direct recruits	Not exceeding 30 years (Relaxable for Government Servants up to 5 years in accordance with the instructions or orders issued by the GOI from time to time) Note: The crucial date for determining the age limit shall be the closing date for receipt of applications from the candidates in India and not the closing date prescribed for those in Assam, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur , Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, Ladakh Division of J & K State, Lahual & Spiti District and Pangi Sub-Division of Chamba District of Himachal Pradesh, Andaman & Nicobar Islands or Lakshdeep.
7	Education and other qualifications required for direct recruits	The following Educational & other Qualifications for direct recruits are required as per the provisions of Entrance and Training Rules (Revised), 2004 for Forest Rangers notified vide GOI, M/O Environment and Forests Notification No GSR 4066 (E) dated 21.7.2004 (or as amended from time to time). <u>Essential</u> 1. <u>Educational Qualifications</u> : Bachelor's Degree in Science or Engineering from any recognised university with atleast one of the following subjects:

(i) Agriculture (ii) Botany (iii) Chemistry (iv) Computer Applications/Computer Science, (v) Engineering (Agriculture/ Chemical/ Civil/ Computer/ Electrical / Electronics/ Mechanical), (vi) Environmental Science (vii) Forestry (viii) Geology (ix) Horticulture (x) Mathematics (xi) Physics (xii) Statistics (xiii) Veterinary Science (xiv) Zoology.

2. Physical Standards

2(a) The minimum standard for height and chest girth for candidates shall be as follows:

The following minimum height standards may be allowed in case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribes and races such as Assamese, Bhutanese, Garwalies, Gorkhas, Kumaonise, Ladakhese, Mizo, Naga, Nepalese, Sikkimiese and those from Arunachal Pradesh, Lahaul & Spiti, Meghalaya:

2(b) Male/ Female Candidates must pass a physical test covering a distance of 25/ 16 Kms within four hours on foot, respectively.

3. Health Certificate:

The medical examination of the candidate by a Medical board shall be arranged. The Medical Board shall issue a health certificate and also certify that the candidate is FIT to undertake strenuous outdoor work in the Department of Forests and Wildlife.

4. The candidate will be selected on the basis of competitive written examination and interview to be conducted by the DSSSB. The merit list shall be prepared on the basis of total marks obtained in written examination and interview.
